BUSINESS ENVIRONMENT



LECTURE ON EXPLORING THE CHANGING TRENDS BUSINESS WORLD










SESSION ON NAVIGATING THE TRANSITION FROM COLLEGE TO CORPORATE








SESSION ON LAUNCHING YOUR FINANCE CAREER

With eleven over years teaching experience at Executive postgraduate, PGP, undergraduate levels, currently, she oversees the implementation edtech of programs outclass and curriculum.


SESSION ON BUSINESS MODEL CANVAS:






LECTURE ON BUILDING INTERVIEW

The event concluded with an interactive question and answer session, fostering meaningful dialogue, encapsulating the event's significance.






Arthvidya, the academic society of VSE, hosted the AI Escape Quest as part of Sankaran 2024, conducted online via Google Meet.




SCAVENGER HUNT












THE GUIDANCE GATEWAY




ADVANCED EXCEL

Can a Collaborative Approach Break the Credit Rating Impasse?

By working together, debtor countries, CRAs, creditors, and international institutions can break the credit rating impasse and pawe the way for sustainable debt relief that fosters economic development and financial stability. Further discussions are crucial to explore and implement these collaborative solutions, transforming the crisis into an opportunity for a more






