Bengaluru: The government has recommended establishing a dedicated AI Governance Board to review and authorise AI applications. The board will make sure that all AI initiatives align with recognised guidelines outlined in domestic and international legal instruments.

The recommendation was made as a part of the Competency Framework for AI for Public Sector Officials on March 6, at the official launch of the AIKosha and AI compute portal by the ministry of electronics and information technology (MeitY).

The board could also play a crucial role in providing oversight and guidance throughout the AI lifecycle, the AI competency framework says. The panel will provide nuanced recommendations, guiding projects to not only meet technical benchmarks but also effectively address societal issues and ethical



vices.
