The law school offers value-added courses and workshops, enhancing critical thinking and contemporary legal knowledge. Short-term training programs keep students updated with evolving legislation and judicial pronouncements.

Beyond academics, soft skills training is prioritised through moot courts, mock trials, youth parliaments, Model United

Nations (MUNs), debates, and ADR competitions such as mediation, arbitration, and negotiation. Legal aid and pro bono activities instil a deep sense of societal responsibility in students.

Research & Intellectual Growth

VSLLS fosters a vibrant research culture, boasting over 45 publications, a monthly newsletter, and an active legal blog. Faculty members and students are engaged in

research projects, conference presentations, and journal publications. The library is well-equipped with digital resources that can be accessed remotely by students and faculty. It is also filled with books, including the Vedas, Upanishads, contemporary legal texts, and case manuals.

A unique addition to the campus is Inner Space, a designated meditation area featuring an inspiring painting of Swami Vivekananda, encouraging students to engage in self-reflection and mindfulness.

Industry Interface & Global Collaborations

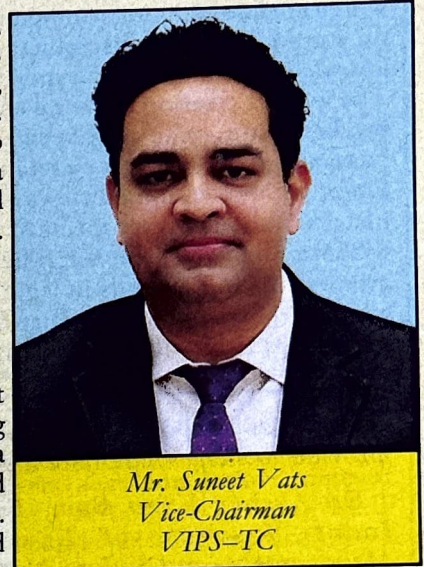
