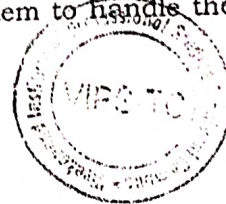
- Q4 Critically examine the nature of inter ethnic and inter caste relationships in India. Does social legislation help in any way to handle this grave issue? (12.5)
